

The City of Gladewater has contracted with [Allied Waste](#) (formally Olympic) (1-800-MR TRASH) to dispose of waste inside the City of Gladewater. Pick-ups are twice a week. Allied is required to pick up no more than 9 bags/cans on the first pick-up of the month and all bags/cans on the second pick-up. Citizens are responsible for their own garbage containers and placing them at the curb before 7:30 a.m. on the day of pick-up. Handicap pick-up service is available. The fee for this mandatory service is included with your monthly water bill.
