[Cemetery](#) - Gladewater Memorial Park Cemetery was established September 11, 1945. The cemetery is located 1.5 miles west on U.S. Highway 80 from the City limits of Gladewater...

[City Manager](#) - The City Manager serves as chief administrative and executive officer of the City and assures that all laws and city ordinances are enforced; and does related work as required. The City Manager appoints and removes all heads of departments and all subordinate officers and employees of the City, except as otherwise provided in the City Charter. The City Manager exercises control over all departments and subdivisions thereof created by the City Charter and City Council...

[City Secretary](#) - The City Secretary attends and records proceedings of official meetings of the City and is the manager and custodian of official records. The City Secretary conducts City elections, including early voting and is the City Treasurer, Finance Department Supervisor, Human Resources and Personnel Director...

[Code Enforcement](#) - The mission of City Building Inspector/Code Enforcement Officer (CEO) is to protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Gladewater...
