

ORDINANCE NO. O-22-01
ORDER FOR CITY OFFICERS ELECTION

STATE OF TEXAS
CITY OF GLADEWATER

I, J.D. Shipp, in my capacity as Mayor of the City of Gladewater, Texas do hereby order that a joint election be held in said City on the 7th day of May 2022 for the purpose of electing the following officials for said City:

MAYOR	PLACE 1
COUNCIL MEMBER	PLACE 2
COUNCIL MEMBER	PLACE 3
COUNCIL MEMBER	PLACE 4 UNEXPIRED TERM

The City will contract with the elections administrator of Gregg County and the elections administrator of Upshur County (individually, the Administrator; together, the Administrators) to conduct all aspects of the Election; and the Election will be conducted by each County and held jointly with other political subdivisions for which each County is also conducting their elections (such other political subdivisions, collectively, the Participants), as provided pursuant to the provisions of an election agreement and/or a joint election or similar agreement between or among (as applicable) the City, each County, and/or any Participants, entered into in accordance with the provisions of Section 271.002, as amended, Texas Election Code; and

GREGG COUNTY ELECTION DAY PRECINCT AND POLLING INFORMATION

- Election Day: Saturday, May 7, 2022
- Election Day Polling Locations open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and are determined by the county utilizing the countywide polling place program under Section 43.007, as amended, Texas Election Code. Registered voters will be able to cast their Election Day ballots at any of the Vote Centers identified on Gregg County's website.

Early voting by mail shall be by paper ballots and voting by personal appearance shall be by a Verity DUO voting system approved by the Secretary of State of Texas and shall be canvassed by an Early Voting Ballot Board, appointed by Upshur County Commissioners Court.

The City of Gladewater has four election precincts, those being 2, 3 and 14 in Upshur County and 13 in Gregg County.

The order in which the names of the candidates are to be printed on the ballot shall be determined by a drawing by the City Clerk as provided in Section 52.094 of the Election Code.

Said election shall be held in accordance with the Election Code of this State, and only resident qualified voters of said City shall be eligible to vote at said election.

The Gregg County Election Administrator and the Upshur County Elections Administrator shall give notice of this election in accordance with the terms and provisions of Section 4.004, 83.010, 85.004 and 85.007 of the Election Code, and all necessary orders and writs for said election shall be issued by the proper authority.
